



Volunteering Expectations For Parents/Guardians of Jr. Legion/Sr. Legion Baseball Players

Parents/Guardians:

It takes MANY individuals to ensure that tournaments and games run smoothly, so your help is essential! We understand that “time” can be a burden for some families, so we have built in the option of payment instead of time.....please note the Volunteer process as outlined in our Board policy:

Volunteer Deposit: \$1,000.00

- Parents are asked to write a separate check to AYBA in the amount of \$1000.00. If the family of each player works **a minimum of 25 hours per player or 40 hours if more than one player is involved**, this check will be shredded at the end of the season. **(Hours worked for high school games and grocery bagging will be applied towards the summer program requirements.)**
- Volunteer time can be done by working at the concession stand when it is in operation, taking tickets at tournaments, working in the press box doing the score clock or visual display board, or other options as determined by the AYBA Board.
- Siblings/family members that are 12 to 17 years old can help in acquiring the necessary hours (working in the concession stand, scoreboard or visual display board) if he/she is accompanied by a parent.
- All families, except those serving as Head Coaches or Assistant Coaches, must work the full amount of hours to receive credit; partial completion will not be accepted.
- If someone is unable to work his/her scheduled shift, it is that person’s responsibility to find a replacement or let Pam Thompson know immediately.
- Sign up for hours will occur through the “Sign Up Genie” which will be run by Pam Thompson, with some exceptions of high school games and grocery bagging.

Parents/Guardians will be contacted with the volunteer options for games/ tournaments via e-mail, so please complete the following information and return to be on the e-mail list. Sign up will occur on a first come, first serve basis. Please refer to the AYBA website for tournament weekends.
